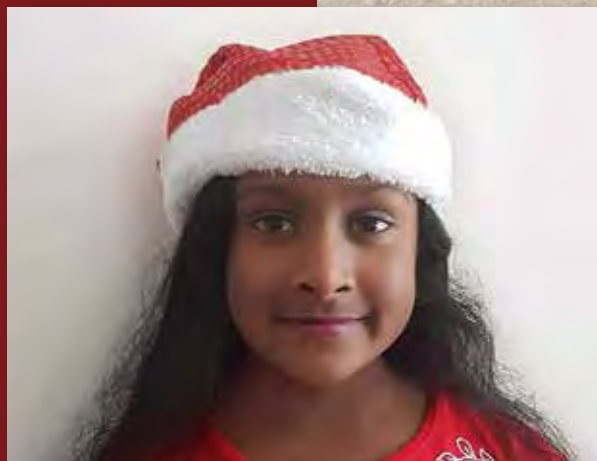
Amy Hall & Ash Bisdee

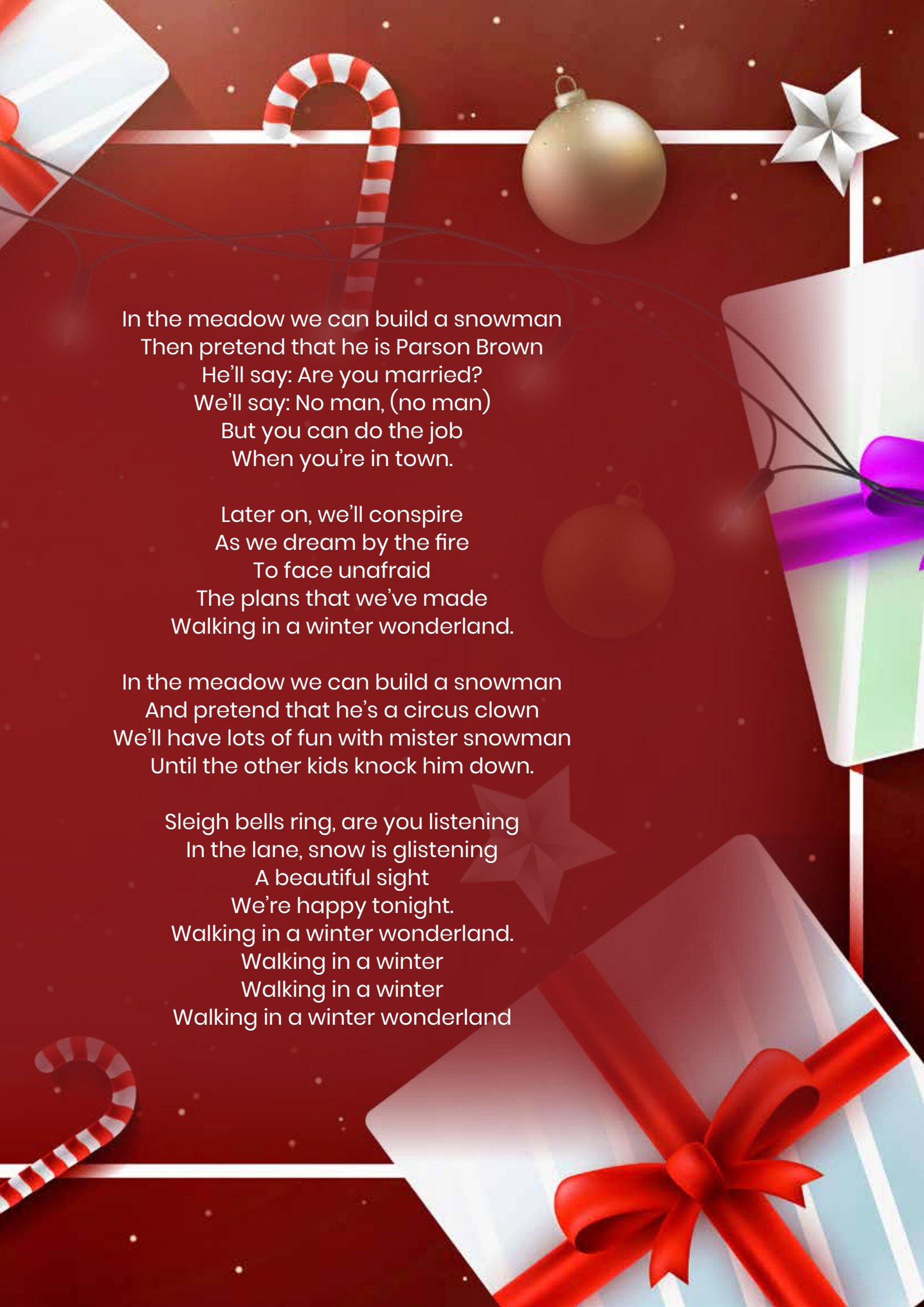
